At Brownsover Hall Hotel we are committed to implementing sustainable practices and proactive environmental measures to help protect and preserve the natural environment for future generations.

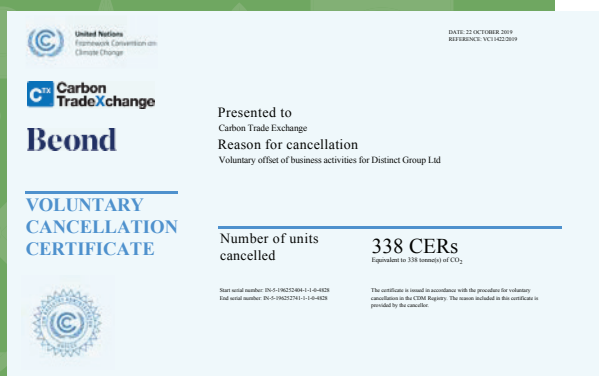

What we are doing

Water Conservation

- Utilising a borehole water supply, reducing reliance on mains water
- Implementing water-saving initiatives across the hotel, including reduced towel usage

Sustainable Food & Growing

- Growing fruit, vegetables, and herbs on-site
- Working with suppliers who prioritise sustainability

Waste Reduction & Recycling

- Using refillable toiletries to reduce plastic waste
- Eliminating single-use plastics where possible
- Recycling glass, cardboard, cooking oil, and aluminium coffee pods
- Composting appropriate kitchen waste on-site
- Compacting waste to reduce collection frequency

Biodiversity & Grounds Management

- Developing formal gardens and woodland areas
- Supporting habitats for local wildlife
- Managing outdoor spaces sustainably

Carbon Reduction

- Reducing emissions through efficient energy use
- Supporting carbon offset initiatives where appropriate

- Transitioning to digital systems
- Working towards a paperless environment

What you can do

Lights

- Please switch off the lights when you leave your hotel room.

Mobile phone chargers

Heating & Air Conditioning

- Check the windows are closed when the heating is on, so heat does not escape.
- If using air conditioning, try not to leave it running at a very high or low temperature.
